Asbestos Removal



Project Name: Crewe British Rail Ticketing Office

Project Scope: Removal of asbestos insulating board debris to contaminated basement floor

Project Value: £52,000.00

SCK Group was commissioned to undertake the safe removal of asbestos containing materials to basement floor areas within a redundant premises once used to print tickets for rail travellers. The building had been un-occupied for many years making the planning and risk assessment process more interesting to our contracts team.

Over the years the condition of the hazardous materials had worsened due to weathering and water ingress and the contamination had spread.

SCK Group assessed the extent of the problem by initially examining the full premises for structural safety and confined space risk prior to the full asbestos scoping works. SCK has skilled competent assessors who can look at projects with health and safety at the fore-front. Space limitations in the surrounding roads posed a problem but this was overcome by ensuring traffic management was adequately policed throughout the project. Working with the client and its nominated sub-contractors, the SCK contracts team was able to formulate a Plan of Work suitable to the environment to ensure that works proceeded efficiently and safely.

Upon completion and independent Four Stage Certificate of Re-Occupation, the client contacts were safely walked around the work areas for re-assurance.
