Asbestos Removal

Project Brief

Decorated with ornaments inspired by natural history the Natural History Museum is a grade 1 listed building.

SCK Group working in conjunction with a skylight program, our operational team and managers worked carefully at height to remove asbestos containing putty and rope seals around window and skylight to the roof areas of the Museum. The project involved cleaning around the skylight casements in preparation for listed glass panes to be reinstated. Independent analytical air testing was carried out during these works, along with strict adherence to Grade 1 listing specifications and criteria.

Due to the Grade 1 listing of the building along with the historical significance of the structure and contents within the buildings meticulous planning and execution of the entire project was critical to achieve the expectations of our client and to ensure the artefacts and building structure would be kept intact for future generations to enjoy, SCK Group proved their versatility and adaptability on a very complicated project with priceless value.



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
